## Our programs

CleanFARMS™ currently operates three stewardship programs on behalf of its members, at no cost to farmers.

### Empty pesticide container recycling

CleanFARMS™ collects empty pesticide containers from more than 1,000 collection sites across the country. The plastic is shredded and safely recycled into new products that can be used back on the farm.

### Obsolete pesticide collection

We collect and safely dispose of obsolete or unwanted pesticides, ensuring chemicals are not released back into the environment.

### Empty pesticide paper bag collection

Empty paper bags are collected at designated sites and safely incinerated. This program successfully launched in Atlantic Canada in 2009 and will be expanding across the country.
